Qualifying for home health support

Eligible patients must be willing to participate in the plan of care established with their physician and Home Health clinicians. Patients must initially demonstrate a need for skilled care provided by a registered nurse or physical therapist, and must experience a great and taxing effort to leave the home. Patients interested in home care services should first make an appointment with their UC Davis physician, who can help decide if the Home Health program is right for them.
