
Add or Remove a Pharmacy from your Pharmacy List



Step-By-Step Instructions

1. Log in to the [MyUCDavisHealth app or web portal](#)





2. Click the **Medications** tab then click on the **Go to Manage My Pharmacies** link (Note: When using the mobile app, tap Medications from the home screen).


