NICU: Small Baby Unit Development

Christa Mu is a Neonatal Clinical Nurse Specialist with 27 years of Neonatal Intensive Care expertise, having worked in high-acuity academic settings around the country, including Children's National Medical Center and Massachusetts General Hospital. For the past 12 years, she has made UC Davis home as a Neonatal Transport Nurse. She returned to school to get master's degrees in nursing education and Clinical Nurse Specialist, with an emphasis on the Parent-Child dyad. Christa is a Clinical Nurses Specialist who specializes in neonatal skin, wound, and ostomy care, as well as intraluminal intestinal rehabilitation in the NICU setting. She also specializes in the difficult care of extremely low birth weight infants from delivery to discharge and is nationally qualified in this area.

Christa received the ANCC Magnet Nurse of the Year Award for New Knowledge, Innovations, and Improvements in 2019 for her contributions to an innovative telehealth service targeted at helping NICU families' transition from the NICU to home.

In 2020, Christa received the National IHI and Daisy Foundation Award for Extraordinary Nurses in Patient Safety for her efforts to standardized neonatal complicated wound care.
