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“Properties, regulation, and functions of Pannexin 1 channels”


Pannexin 1 channels are implicated in an expanding number of (patho)physiological contexts, mostly by virtue of their ability to release intercellular signaling metabolites in an activation-dependent manner. In this presentation, we will examine the atypical channel activation mechanisms, and the salient Panx1 properties and permeation characteristics, that are associated with different physiological conditions.
